



STEP 1:

Remove

Wearing protective gloves, carefully remove the thermostat from the wall and place it inside a sealed clear bag – collection locations may have these bags available if you do not. Do NOT disassemble or attempt to remove the mercury-containing glass tube inside the thermostat. Drop-off locations will not accept broken or disassembled thermostats.

STEP 2:

STEP 3:

Fill Out Rebate Form

Download, print, and fill out the rebate form to receive a **\$30 mail-in rebate** per mercury thermostat. Collection locations should also have these forms available and with carbon-backing to supply a copy of the form for you.

STEP 4:

Drop Off

Take your thermostat and completed rebate form to your drop-off location and speak with the location's associate to place it in the labeled mercury thermostat drop-off container. Make sure the location's associate places the rebate form inside of a plastic bag with your mercury thermostat to keep those items together for processing. If you don't use a carbon-backed rebate form from the location, take a photo of your form for reference. We advise you to also take a photo of your thermostat for reference of its applicability for the rebate.



STEP 5:

Receive Rebate

You will receive your rebate in the form of a check when the thermostat has been verified as a mercury thermostat and processed at the safe disposal center. This process may take up to one year.
