

SAFE MERCURY THERMOSTAT DISPOSAL *For HHWs*



As a Thermostat Care partner, your facility prevents mercury contamination by offering a collection location for residents to safely dispose of their mercury thermostats.



Mercury Thermostat Collection Steps:



Once you've received your collection container, open the container to find helpful materials



Accept mercury thermostats & ensure they are each in a sealed bag



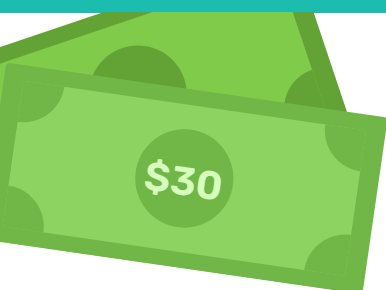
Schedule a FedEx Ground pickup <1 year after accumulation start date



Use the pre-paid return label to safely send back your container and a replacement container will be sent to you. If you do not receive another container within 4 weeks, please contact Info@ThermostatCare.org



Thermostat Care takes care of all shipping logistics to ensure regulations are met



Residents and service technicians who safely turn in their **mercury thermostat(s)** to your location are eligible for a **\$30 mail-in rebate!** Get rebate forms at ThermostatCare.org.



Reminders for Proper Mercury Thermostat Disposal:

- Mercury thermostats must be managed in a way that prevents release to the environment (e.g., in a sealed bag inside a sealed bin or pail)
- **NEVER** remove the mercury ampule from the thermostat
- Universal waste such as mercury-containing thermostats can be stored for up to a year only
- Improperly disposing of mercury-containing thermostats in trash is prohibited and subject to a fines
